This is the first proposal that wasn't a takeback, so maybe this will be a trend that starts us in a positive direction; only time will tell.

We have engaged in subcommittee meetings on various topics, and those discussions will persist with the aim of achieving a positive outcome. The team has scheduled more subcommittee discussions on outstanding MOAs with the expectation of collaborative effort to obtain a resolution on those items.

The company finally responded to some of the Union's proposals by **rejecting** them. The bargaining team reiterated to the company that we are demanding items that benefit the membership and improve the working conditions for all.
